

Town of Edwards Cemetery Records

Riverside Cemetery:

Located in the village on Church Street ... This burial ground was established between 1858 and 1865 on land purchased from, or donated by, Thomas Noble. It was later expanded by purchase of more land from Mr. Noble along the same street. Stones dated earlier indicate that original burials were in the first village cemetery and moved to Riverside Cemetery.
